NAIDOC WEEK in C2

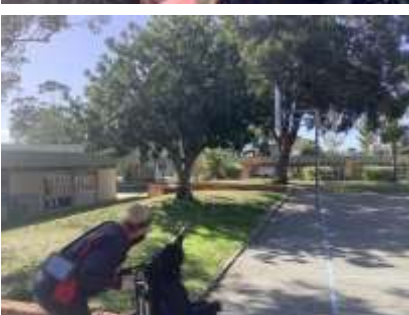
C2 celebrated and learnt about our local Noongar culture during NAIDOC week.

Did you get a chance to look in the For Parents tab on the Burbridge School website last term?

A variety of new website links have been added in various new sections in the For Parents - Resources tab. Here are a few more examples:

Does your family include children, such as siblings of your child who attends Burbridge School? Have you considered the Young Carers program supports and advocacy? A “young carer” is a person under the age of 25 who helps support a member of their household who is experiencing a mental health challenge, disability, long term health condition (including a chronic condition or terminal illness), a substance dependency or who is frail aged.

Have a look under the Young Carers section for the Young Carers/Carers WA link to find out if this support might be just right for your young carer!

Have you been to the local Child and Parent Centre? Have a look under the Early Childhood Supports section for the links to the Roseworth Child and Parent Centre.
